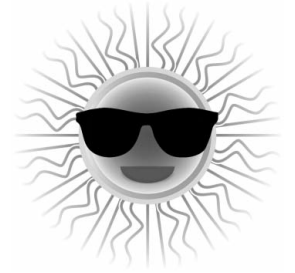


EVENTS IN REVIEW

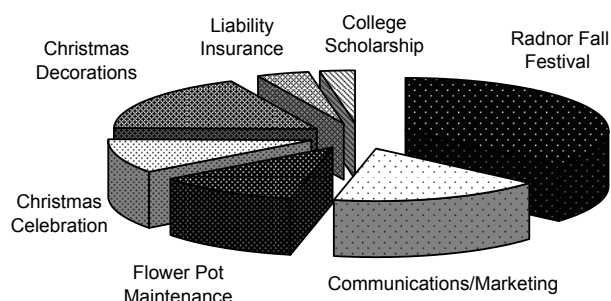

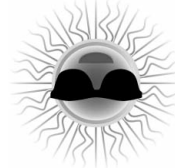

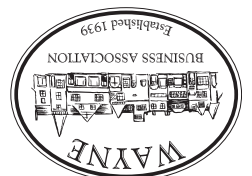
