Wayne Jewelers was originally established in Wayne in 1947. Reid, originally from Canada, joined the Wayne team in the late 1990s to help for the holidays, and never left. In 1999, the store reopened at the corner of North Wayne and Lancaster Avenues and had been in business there for 25 years.

Wayne Jewelers was known for offering beautiful traditional fine jewelry in classic styles, specializing in offerings like charm bracelets, lockets, pins, and brooches that were destined to become family heirlooms. Set along the Main Line, Wayne Jewelers had long been the go-to destination for the community's gift-giving needs including bridal registries, engagement rings, and the births of children.






